

#### Focus on

Dutch National Growth Fund invests €124.5 million in animal-free biomedical research

The Dutch National Growth Fund is investing €124.5 million in a new Centre for Biomedical Translational Research (CPBT) without the use of animals to accelerate this transition over the next decade. The CPBT will initially focus on diseases such as ALS, cystic fibrosis, osteoarthritis/rheumatoid arthritis and asthma/BPCO, through close collaboration between researchers and companies. #### The New York Declaration on Animal Consciousness



On April 19, 2024, during a conference organized by New York University, the New York Declaration on Animal Consciousness was released. This declaration, initially co-signed by 40 actors including scientists and philosophers, supports the realistic possibility of an experience of consciousness in all vertebrates and many invertebrates. This underlines the need to consider changes to current scientific practices. Find out more
